WHY DEAN

Founded in 1865; Dean College has welcomed International students for over 150 years. Located in the Greater Boston area, we are a small and supportive home to 1,200 full-time students from all over the world. We are ranked in the top 25 for Best Regional Colleges North and as a top regional college with the Most International Students by *U.S. News & World Report*.

- Flexible admissions for students with strong academics and more modest English proficiency scores, with immediate credit bearing classes for all students; including those needing English language support
- Residential College, with guaranteed housing for entirety of either 2 or 4 year programs, students are part of the community, have access to activities, services and strong academic support
- Extremely safe and secure suburban setting with 24-hour 7 day a week on-campus security

With small class sizes – 18:1 student-teacher ratio and no class larger than 40 students, personal attention is the cornerstone of **The Dean Difference**.

UNIQUE

We award both four-year bachelor's and two-year associate degrees, providing an educational option that is rare among U.S. colleges. Many of our International students take advantage of our 2-year Associate Degree at Dean and then transfer to top universities in the US and Canada, with a 98% success rate, such as:

FULL SERVICE RESIDENTIAL CAMPUS

We give our students a full college life experience, by offering everything under the Dean umbrella.

- Extensive support to help students assimilate includes our International student advisor who helps with immigration regulations, cultural adjustment and orientation, an International Student Association and themed activities throughout the year, personal academic advising, learning support services and assistance with math and writing, and our highly successful International Focus Program
- International students are expected to live on campus in one of our 13 residence halls; staffed by professionals. One hall is primarily for international students who wish to live with other international students. Each residence hall room has Internet and cable TV service, and students have access to common laundry facilities, kitchenettes, study areas and lounges
- Our meal plan provides unlimited access to the College's main dining facility. Students can choose from a variety of entrees, soups and salads, fresh fruits, deli sandwiches and vegetarian alternatives
- Campus Safety provides 24-hour coverage, seven days a week; the mission is to keep the campus safe and secure, and Franklin is consistently voted as one of the safest cities in Massachusetts www.dean.edu/safety
- Student Life Clubs and Organizations, entertainment activities, ongoing theatre and dance performances, and athletic events make Dean's campus a fun and vibrant community. International students are encouraged to get involved to build lifelong friendships, try new cultural experiences and develop leadership skills
- Health and Counseling services are staffed by a highly skilled and caring team of professionals. In the event of an emergency, hospitals are minutes away from campus

ATHLETICS AND RECREATION

APPROXIMATE DISTANCES FROM BOSTON


New York City: 186 miles (299 km), 1 hour by plane

ADMISSION

Applying to Dean College has never been easier. We do not charge an application fee, and we are proud to accept the Common Application. You can also apply online through our website at www.dean.edu/international_apply.

We encourage international students to apply well in advance in order to have sufficient time to schedule a visa interview and make travel arrangements.

Each student's application is evaluated individually. Dean has no minimum GPA (grade point average) or standardized test score prerequisite (SAT or ACT). We consider writing ability (personal statement), recommendations and national examination results, if applicable.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY AND ESL SUPPORT

We know that students for whom English is a second language may score lower on the TOEFL, IELTS and Cambridge English or equivalent exams, despite having a good academic record. When this is the case, students may enroll in our International Student FOCUS Program, in which they receive English language support in credit-bearing classes that count toward their bachelor's or associate degree.
